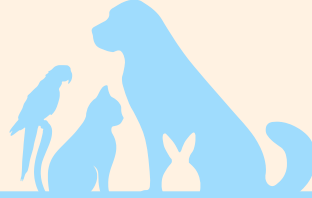

We are much more than just an animal charity; we are about social justice and equity. 200 years ago, three men shared a vision in a coffee shop on Slaughterhouse Lane, London. One of them, Hull born emancipator William Wilberforce MP. His legacy lives on in Hull and East Riding, our work with animals, for animals remains our true north. Our mission has a wider impact on society educating people about the 5 animal welfare needs, helping our community be more resilient through volunteering, employment opportunities, and supporting mental health through social prescribing.

Our Branch is over 120 years old; we are a local and independent Branch of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals. Our Animal Rescue Centre is for the community and supported by the community of Hull and East Riding.

We have a dedicated team at the Hull & East Riding, and we live up to our organisational values. Working or volunteering for the Branch brings with it an expectation of positive behaviours that demonstrate professionalism, kindness, and friendliness.

Our destination is a culture of inclusivity. We are all passionate about our people and their skills that collectively come together to form a multi-dimensional presence. Our culture first approach is our north star and handrail to ensuring we can be the very best version of ourselves.

The RSPCA Hull and East Riding Branch is an independent local charity operating under the strictest rules and guidance of our national body.

Our branch is committed to providing a consistent care pathway for all the animals that come into our care.

In some rare and difficult cases veterinary surgeons make the decision to euthanise animals, this is done as the very last option and is based on the best outcome of the animal.



Our Mission and Vision

"We are a locally funded Charity serving Hull & East Riding. Our mission is to rehabilitate and rehome animals that have suffered cruelty, neglect, or abandonment.

Our purpose is clear: to be the voice of animals for as long as they need us. We will continue our tireless efforts, to change the lives of animals in need, to work with the community, to educate and advise, improving the quality of life for animals in partnership with the National RSPCA."



We are an independent Branch of the RSPCA operating in the Hull and East Riding of Yorkshire. We provide support to the National Society by providing state of the art accommodation for animals that are abandoned, abused, neglected sick or injured.

Our Animal Welfare Centre is located on Clough Road and our team of staff and volunteers care for dogs, cats, rabbits, guinea pigs and ferrets. **We help to rehabilitate and rehome the most vulnerable animals.**

The Branch is operated by a Board of trustees, elected by the local members as their representatives for the implementation of local policies, although the Branch is run in accordance with the National Society policy structure and aims. This allows the Branch to meet the needs of the local community which is very important to us.



Our History. The National Society was formed almost 200 years ago, Hull-born slave emancipator William Wilberforce MP, being among its founders. The objectives then, as now, were to prevent cruelty to animals by all lawful means and promote kindness. The society was granted royal patronage by Queen Victoria in 1840.

The Hull and East Riding branch, an unincorporated charitable organisation founded in 1903, continues this work as an independent charity.

The animal centre has existed on its current site located on Clough Road after being officially opened by Lady Atkinson on Friday 25th March 1938.
